

Jeptha Strickland Will Hancock County Georgia 1848

This Will of Jeptha Strickland is transcribed from the Original Will recorded in Hancock County, Georgia. I typed the words just as they were spelled in the original Will.

Georgia

Hancock County}

In the name of the Living God I Jeptha Strickland of the County and State aforesaid being of sound mind and desposing memory and disposition, and disposition of the property of which I may be possessed, do make ordain and publish the following Testamentary Will disposition there of that is to say,

Item 1 I give and bequeath my land to my two grand nieces Elisabeth J Muse and Gillean C. Muse and My Grand Nephew James C.?. Muse, My Sister Morning having the use and control of the land her life time (That is during her natural life)

Item 2 I give and bequeath my bed to my grand niece Gillean C. Muse

Item 3 [Blurred] give and bequeath my horse [Blurred]—Nephew James C.?. Muse

Item 4 I give and bequeath my hogs cattle [blurred]--- effects of which I may be possessed [blurred]—sister Morning.

I nominate my Nephew Daniel Muse executor of this my Will hereby [can't read]—any and all former wills by me made and disclaiming this to be my sole last will and testament.
